

Team Registration Procedures for Team Captains 2017 Walk for Autism & 5K

- Each team will have a designated Team Captain. This person is responsible for registration procedures, donation collections, and packet pickup for their team. Register your team at https://runsignup.com/Race/IN/Boonville/AutismEvansvilleWalk5K and assist team members who will walk and/or run at the event in registering online.
- 2. Provide each team member who is walking or running with a sponsor form for collecting pledges from those who won't be attending the event. Donations can be made by cash or check. Checks should be made payable to Autism Evansville.
- 3. Please make sure each team member who is attending the event is registered by Sunday, March 5th (we need this time to print shirts before you pick them up at Team Packet Pickup on March 14th). You can help team members with this by emailing a link of the registration page, and sending reminders via email and your social media accounts.
- 4. All donations collected (from people unable to attend the event) are to be turned in to the Team Captain, or made online through the registration website. There are no provisions for paper registrations except for late registration on the day of the event, and this increases the registration fee by \$5 each. All other registrations are to be entered online.
- 5. Team members registering after March 31st are not guaranteed a t-shirt. Team members who register after March 5th may pick up their own packets at early packet pickup on April 7th or at the registration tables on the day of the event.
- 6. Any other donations received by Team Captains after March 14th can be turned in on the day of the event at the Team Captain table.
- 7. Due to order processing times, Team Captain incentive prizes are based on the total collected and turned in by your team by March 14th. Incentive prizes will be distributed at the event at the Team Captain table.
