(Overtime called daily)
Basic Life Skills course once weekly
Work Mentor

ELIGIBILITY

- Age: 18+ & Qualifying Disability
- Possess a government picture ID
- Up-to-date immunizations
- Clean Drug Screen & Felony Check
- Be Eligible for Indiana VR or Private Pay
- Sign Agreement to Complete Full Apprenticeship and follow all rules related to apprenticeship

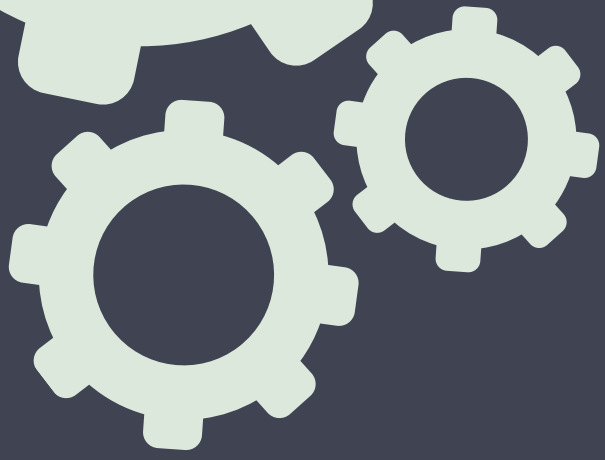
